As a member of **Club PERÓ**, a parent/s and/or guardian/s of a student/s is required to comply with the **Club PERÓ** Member Protection Policy and General Code of Behaviour, in addition to this Code of Behaviour. The parent/s and/or guardian/s must meet the following requirements during any activity held or sanctioned by **Club PERÓ**, Gymnastics NSW, Gymnastics Australia:

### APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others;
2. Remember that your child participates in sport for their own enjoyment, not yours;
3. Focus on your child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing;
4. Never ridicule or yell at your child and other children for making a mistake or losing a competition;
5. Show appreciation for good performance by all gymnasts, including gymnasts from other teams;
6. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with or in the vicinity of persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example;
7. Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise;
8. Do not physically or verbally abuse or harass anyone associated with the sport (player, coach, judge and so on);
9. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, race, place of origin, athletic potential, colour, sexual orientation, religion, political beliefs, socio-economic status and other conditions;
10. Be a positive role model; and
11. Understand the repercussions if you breach, or are aware of any breaches of, this code of behaviour.

The gymnast/s must meet the following requirements during any activity held or sanctioned by **Club PERÓ**, Gymnastics NSW, Gymnastics Australia, and/or any role as a gymnast appointed/within **Club PERÓ**:

#### APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow students, coaches, officials and spectators;
2. Do not tolerate acts of aggression;
3. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow students and competitors;
4. Care for and respect the equipment provided to you as part of your program;
5. Be frank and honest with your coach concerning illness and injury and your ability to train fully within the program requirements;
6. At all times avoid intimate relationships with your coach;
7. Conduct yourself in a professional manner relating to language, temper and punctuality;
8. Maintain high personal behaviour standards at all times;
9. Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for yourself and your team;
10. Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured; and
11. Cooperate with coaches and staff in development of programs to adequately prepare you for competition at the highest level.
