As a member of **Club PERÓ**, a parent/s and/or guardian/s of a student/s is required to comply with the **Club PERÓ** Member Protection Policy and General Code of Behaviour, in addition to this Code of Behaviour. The parent/s and/or guardian/s must meet the following requirements during any activity held or sanctioned by **Club PERÓ**, Gymnastics NSW, Gymnastics Australia :

APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others;
2. Remember that your child participates in sport for their own enjoyment, not yours;
3. Focus on your child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing;
4. Never ridicule or yell at your child and other children for making a mistake or losing a competition;
5. Show appreciation for good performance by all gymnasts, including gymnasts from other teams;
6. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with or in the vicinity of persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example;
7. Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise;
8. Do not physically or verbally abuse or harass anyone associated with the sport (player, coach, judge and so on);
9. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, race, place of origin, athletic potential, colour, sexual orientation, religion, political beliefs, socio-economic status and other conditions;
10. Be a positive role model; and
11. Understand the repercussions if you breach, or are aware of any breaches of, this code of behaviour.
